PROGRAM:

Monday 29 September 2025

SL 2 x 1 run Slalom races – Mt Hutt NZL National Points Race

ELIGIBILITY:

These races are for the U14, U16 & U19 age groups. Athletes must be registered with Snow Sports NZ as well as having National Points membership.

ENTRY:

Entries and payment must be made online through the Snow Sports NZ website:

ENTRY CLOSES Wednesday 24 September 2025 @ 3pm.

Any entries after this date and time will be considered late entries. Late entries are at the discretion of the Timer and ROC and if accepted will be subject to a \$100 late entry fee per race, in addition to race entry fees. Late fees are payable immediately, directly to NZ Ski via credit card at Guest Services prior to racing.

QUALIFICATION:

The start list will be seeded according to the rules for NZ National Points.

ENTRY FEES:

Slalom (National Points Race) \$90.00 / day





ATHLETE AND COACH LIFT PASSES:

- \$57.50 for Under 16
- \$87.50 for 16+

Discounted lift price is for competitors only. Coaches are entitled to a FOC lift pass for every 6 competitors entered. Coaches with less than 6 competitors the lift cost is \$87.50. Additional coaches are also entitled to discounted lift passes at \$87.50. Coaches must be a coach of a program recognised by SSNZ (not a parent).

If a race or races are postponed or cancelled on a scheduled race date the discount is no longer available and all lift passes will be full price.

There will be no pass purchase at Team Captains meeting. Passes may be purchased at Guest Services on the mountain in the morning, or this can also be done at the Methven down town NZ Ski office prior to 4pm. (Note the office closes at 4pm, so it is advised to go earlier). Please note that payment must be made in full before any lift passes can be issued and uplifted from Guest Services. Lifts open at 9am for competitors.
