GENERAL RULES

The Competition is organised according to the ICR, FIS and WSF rules.

ELIGIBILITY

Athletes are eligible if born in 2003, 2002, or 2001.

To be eligible for the concurrently running FIS NZ Freestyle Open, athletes must hold a valid FIS license and be entered by their governing bodies. All athletes entered born 2001, 2002 or 2003 will automatically be included in the NZ Rookie Fest division and earn points on the World Rookie Tour.

LIFT TICKETS

Lift tickets will be on sale at Team Captain's Meeting. Lift Tickets for athletes will be issued at a discounted rate of \$65/day. Complimentary passes will be issued to coaches listed on entry form to a limit of 1 pass per team of 8 athletes or part thereof.

INFO & ENTRY

Entries for NZ Rookie Fest without a FIS license should be done through the form here. If athletes are participating in the FIS category, they must be entered on the official FIS entry form. All athletes entered born 2001, 2002 or 2003 will automatically be included in the NZ Rookie Fest division and earn points on the World Rookie Tour.

Entry fee for this event is \$60 per discipline day, and will be collected at Team Captain's meetings. Late entries may be accepted at the Team Captain's Meeting and will incur a late entry fee of \$20.
