International competitors will be placed into an age group based on their year of birth. (Age limit: 17 years old as at 31 December 2019.)

An international quota of 10 athletes (combined male and female) per event per discipline will be enforced if necessary with Australia being the last nation to receive a quota.

EVENT REGISTRATION

Entry can only be completed online after SSNZ membership has been completed & paid. Competitors will receive confirmation once entry has been received. Please ensure all contact details are included to enable follow up enquiries. Entries close 5pm Wednesday September 25, 2019.

LIFT TICKETS & BIB COLLECTION

Bib collection & ticketing will be available at the team captains meeting on Sunday September 29 between 1-6pm at the Snow Sports NZ office, 78 Anderson Rd, Wanaka. Competitor lift passes are available child \$45/day. Parent passes are available for \$90/day. The rider's briefing is at 3pm and will be filmed on Facebook Live for athletes/parents to view at their own discretion. All participants should either attend or watch the online video.

COMMUNICATION

All communication for NZ Junior Freestyle Nationals and NZ Showdown will be through the official Facebook event pages for each event.

A secondary communication channel through a WhatsApp group will be distributed at the Team Captain's meeting, the WhatsApp group will be used primarily for FIS event updates.

EVENT FORMATS & RULES

SX/SBX: No race suits. International rules for SX & SBX clothing apply. One run time trial qualifier. Top 25 - 50% of the field progress through to Semis & Finals (dependent on size of fields). All race protests must be made IMMEDIATELY at the race finish line or to the Chief of Course within 30 minutes of the incident.

Freeride: No man-made features allowed on course one judged run best run counts (straight finals) A result can be taken from the first run scores providing all competitors have completed their first run.

Halfpipe: Two judged runs best score counts (straight finals). Competitors must compete in their age group.

Slopestyle: Two judged runs best score counts (straight finals).

FIS ANC Halfpipe: Two judged runs prior to the start of NZ Junior Freestyle Nationals halfpipe

Torpedo7 NZ Showdown: Two judged runs. Overall event podiums awarded. FIS and WRT results separate.

OVERALL INDIVIDUAL CHAMPIONS

An Overall Individual Champion will be awarded for each age division, gender, ski and snowboard. Points are awarded based on the competitor's placing in all disciplines. A competitor must compete in all disciplines to be considered for Overall Champion in their age group (unless any discipline is cancelled). Overall Champion will be awarded to the competitor who has the most points (regardless of nationality). Points are awarded on the below scale modeled off the FIS 1000 Point Scale.
